Bishop's Annual Ministries Appeal

Now that Lent has begun, the parish once again makes the appeal for the special ministries of the Diocese of Monterey. These activities are not associated with a specific parish. Abstinence on Lenten Fridays

 The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Abstinence is required of all Catholics over the age of 14 (no upper limit). This means that no meat or meat products (soups, gravies, consommés, etc.) are to be eaten on the Fridays of Lent. These regulations are considered to be a serious obligation for all Catholics. However, those who are ill, pregnant, on medication or special diets for health concerns or those who must work at extremely physical jobs may be exempt from these regulations.

Adult Confirmation

The Bishop's Office has informed the parishes that adult Confirmation will take place in May. Any adult member of the parish who has received First Communion, but not Confirmation, is encouraged to consider preparing for Confirmation. The ceremony and retreat will take place in our own parish this year for San Luis Obispo County. The agreed date is May 16th. If interested, please contact Father Victor soon at 773-2219.

Five Cities Christian Women Meet

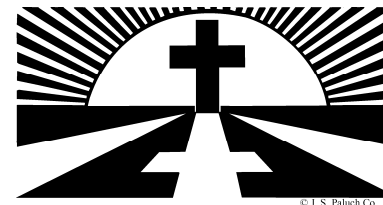
