Mass Intentions—Saturday Night and Sunday

With the growth of the parish and the ever-increasing number of requests for Mass intentions to be placed on the weekend, guidelines were established to allow a more equitable distribution of intentions. So more families will have a chance to place intentions on the weekend, the following continues to apply:

1. Each extended family will have the opportunity to request up to four intentions per calendar year at a specific weekend Mass time (e.g., 10:30 a.m. Sunday);
2. Each extended family may request up to eight (8) intentions per calendar year distributed among the various times of the Saturday night and Sunday Masses;
3. Each extended family will be asked to distribute the intentions throughout the year, so that usually no more than one intention occurs each month.

All requests for these weekend intentions should be directed IN WRITING to Father Victor, who will make the assignment of times and dates.

The Mass book for 2012 has now been opened. Father Victor will begin making assignments around the first week of October. Please have any special requests for a weekend or for a specific date in 2012 to Father Victor by October 1.
